## About the Healthy Baby Contest

## FAQ

### **How will the child be judged?**

Each child is judged according to the following categories: Physical Appearance, Healthiness, and Personality. Each category is rated on a 25-point scale, from excellent to poor.

### **How are the scores determined?**

A panel of judges, selected by the Honolulu Chinese Jaycees, will provide scores for each child based on the above categories. Then, a team of independent accountants will calculate the judging sheets for each child to determine the average score.

### **Can the child wear a costume?**

Yes, the child may wear a costume. However, he or she will not be judged on the costume.

### **When will the finalists be announced?**

Parents/guardians of the 50 finalists will be contacted on Sunday, September 21, between 6pm-9pm by the Honolulu Chinese Jaycees. The child's parent/guardian listed on the registration form will be called directly at the phone numbers listed.
